Collecting at 3.20: Please come up the ramp at 3.15 and wait at the Nursery door.</p>
<p>This term learning will focus on</p>	<p>Learning routines, making friends, sharing and taking turns. Getting to know each other, sharing our likes and dislikes, exploring feelings and behaviour. Enjoying a range of stories & learning poems. Developing gross and fine motor skills. Playing number games and developing counting skills. Finding out about different celebrations including Bonfire Night, Remembrance Day, Diwali, Hanukkah & Christmas</p>
<p>What to bring to Nursery</p>	<p>-Named water bottle - This will be sent home to be washed and refilled daily. -Spare clothes – kept in a bag on your child’s peg. Please do not send any other toys, books or personal possessions into Nursery. Please check your child’s tray regularly (in the cloakroom) for artwork.</p>
<p>Lunch Club</p>	<p>Please remember to cut grapes/olives lengthwise (to avoid choking hazard). Do not send any food items containing nuts or nut butters. Please make sure you check packaging. Please make sure your child’s lunch box is clearly named.</p>
<p>Creative/messy play Fund</p>	<p>We would really appreciate a contribution of £5 each half term which will help to provide cooking ingredients, craft materials and other special resources. Please place your contribution (£10 for the whole term if preferred) in an envelope and hand it to a member of the Nursery team - Thank you!</p>
<p>Learning Journals</p>	<p>Your child will have a Learning Journal. This will be a book that contains observations, photographs and samples of work and provides evidence of your child’s learning journey. We will invite parents into see these journals during open afternoons.</p>
<p>Google classroom</p>	<p>We will be sending logins for Google Classroom shortly so you can join the Nursery classroom. Do look out for weekly updates, each Thursday, on learning in school and how you can help at home.</p>
<p>Outdoor clothing</p>	<p>We aim to go outside everyday so please make sure your child has appropriate clearly named outdoor clothing, e.g. coat, sunhat and appropriate footwear. When the temperature gets colder, please send a named hat and mittens (not gloves) for your child to wear.</p>

Birthdays	We are looking forward to celebrating your child's birthday with them. Please remember that we encourage children to bring in a birthday book to share with the class. This book is then kept in the class library for the whole class to enjoy. A sticker is stuck in the front of the book to remind us of who donated the wonderful book to our library.
